 - Kendo



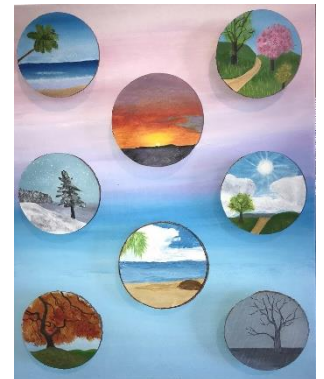
- ※ Week 2: Mini Wooden Classical Lamps and Nightlights

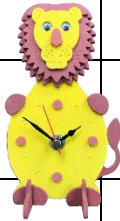
